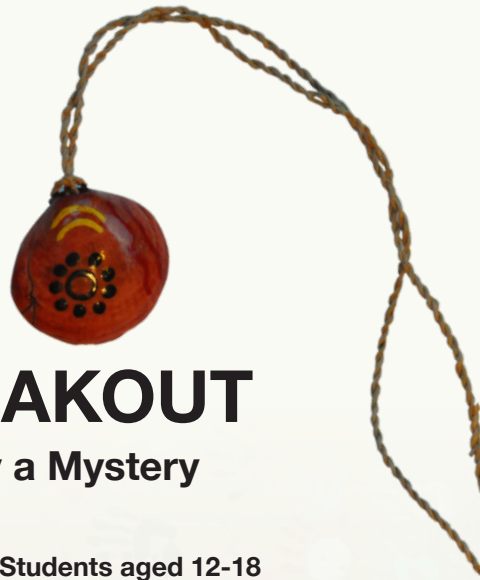

on **17 October 2018 in Hobart.**
