

Understanding the Voice Workshops

Later this year, Tasmanians will vote on the referendum to formally recognise the First Peoples of Australia in the Constitution and establish a permanent Indigenous voice to Parliament. (The Voice.)

In preparation for this historic vote, and with the generous support of the Tasmanian Community Fund, Reconciliation Tasmania is offering all Tasmanian businesses and community organisations the opportunity to book a **free**, in-house workshop that we have developed on “Understanding the Voice”.

The workshop will be delivered by one of our facilitators and is designed to run for about 1 hour with a group of about 10-25 people.

The workshop is informed by resources we have developed about:

- lutruwita/Tasmania's history,
- the Uluru Statement and
- the Constitution and referendum process.

Small group work is combined with whole group discussion, sharing and reflecting on what the groups have discussed.

Reconciliation Tasmania’s approach is to educate people and provide quality, factual information to enable Tasmanians to make an informed choice on the voice. The workshop does not include any questions asking how people intend to vote, and we do not tell people how they should vote.

Bookings are open now with workshops available from July 9 until the referendum is held, which is expected to be mid-October.
