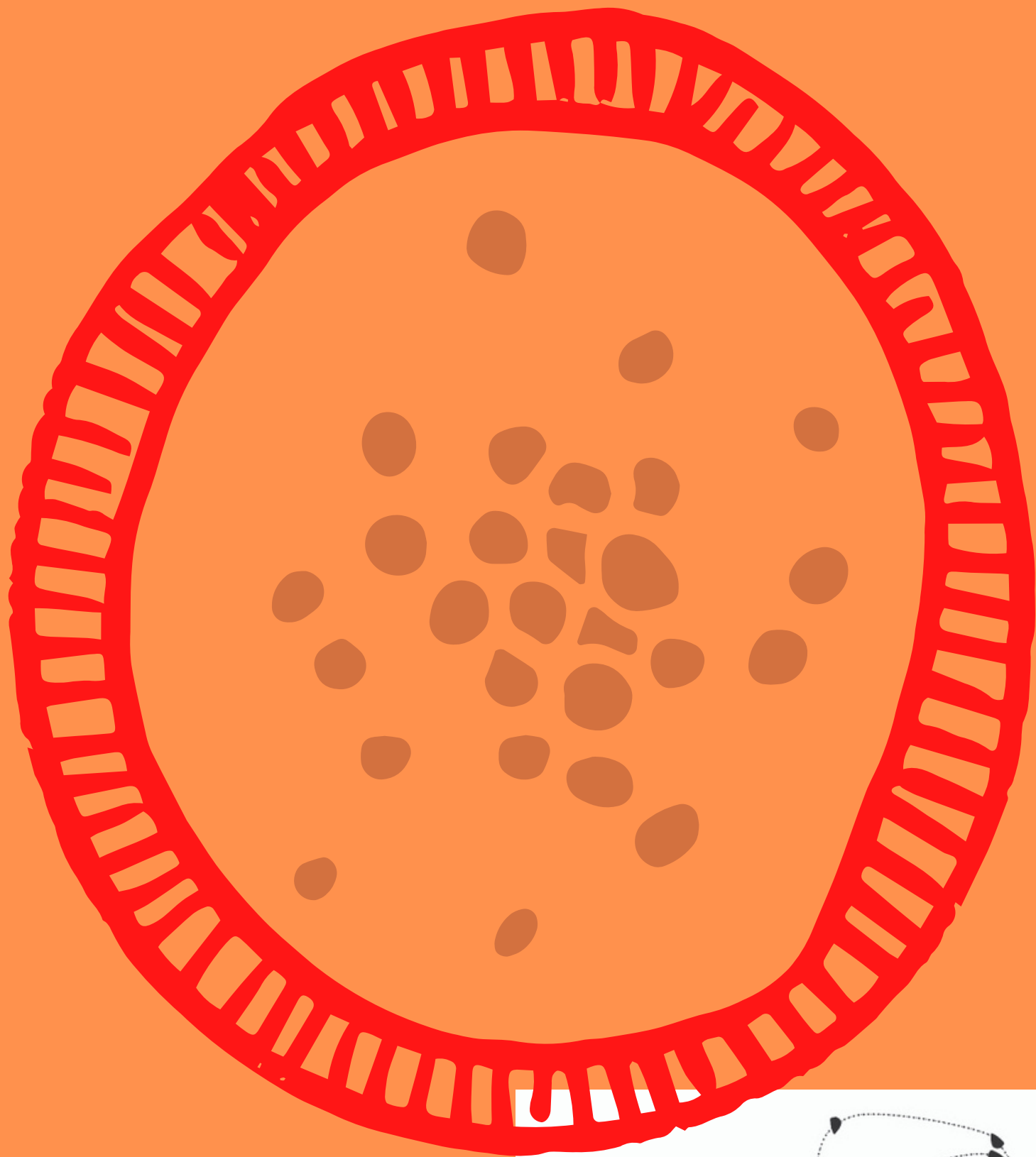


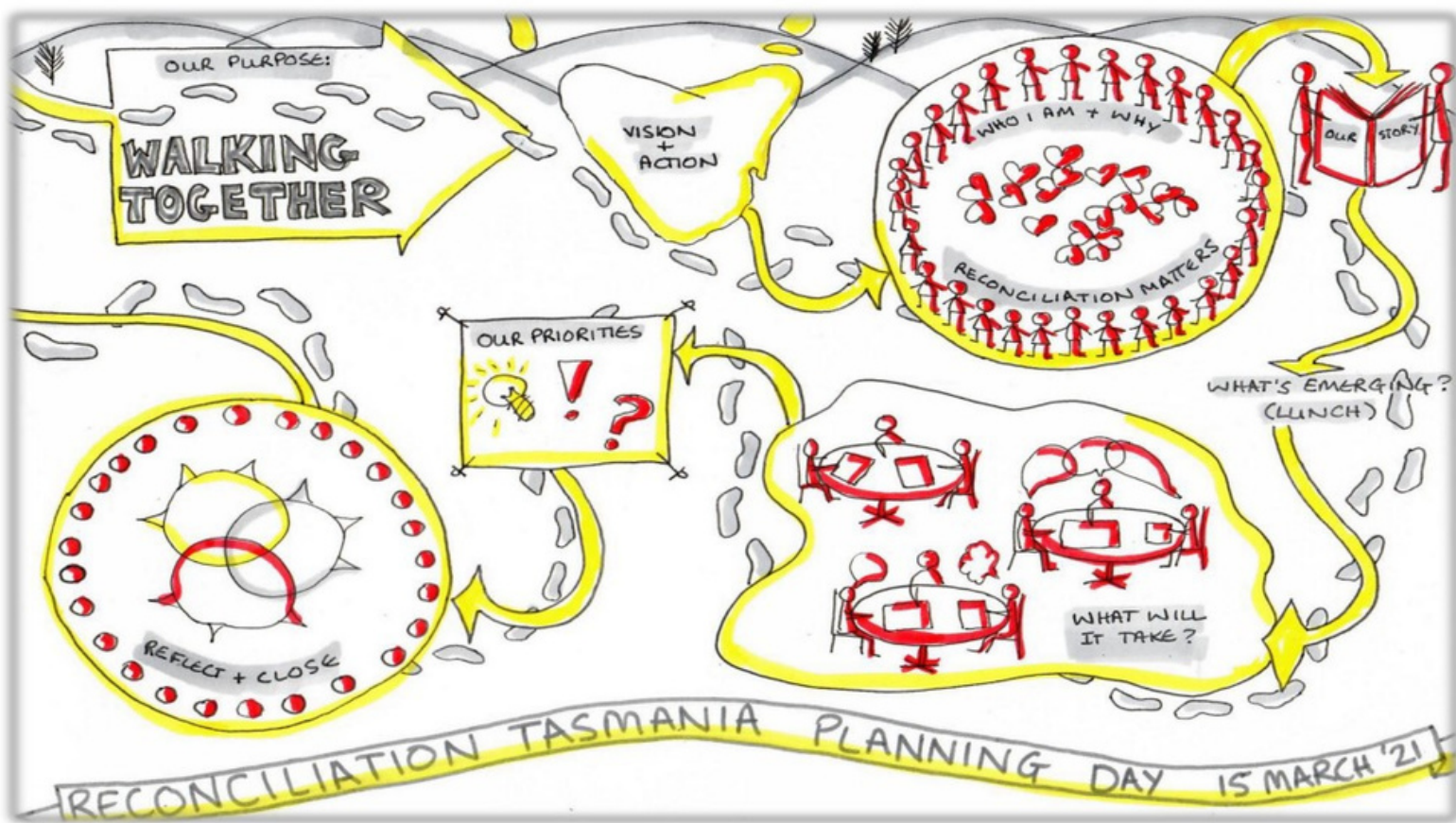

The document you're about to read was born out of those sessions and sets a course for RT's direction, focus and activities over the coming 5 years.

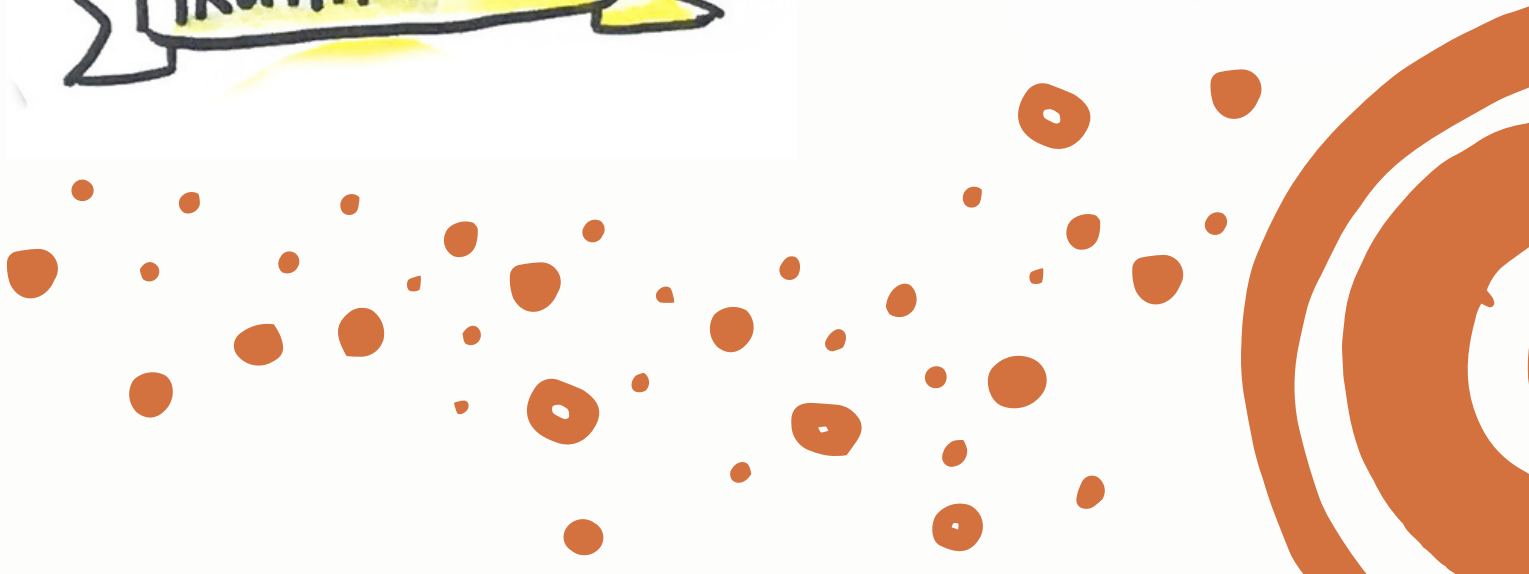
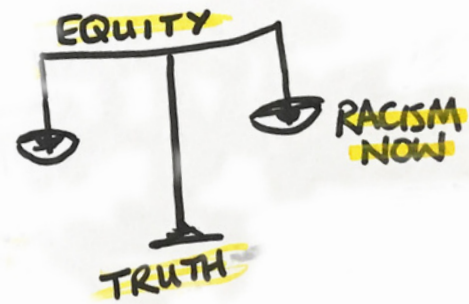
