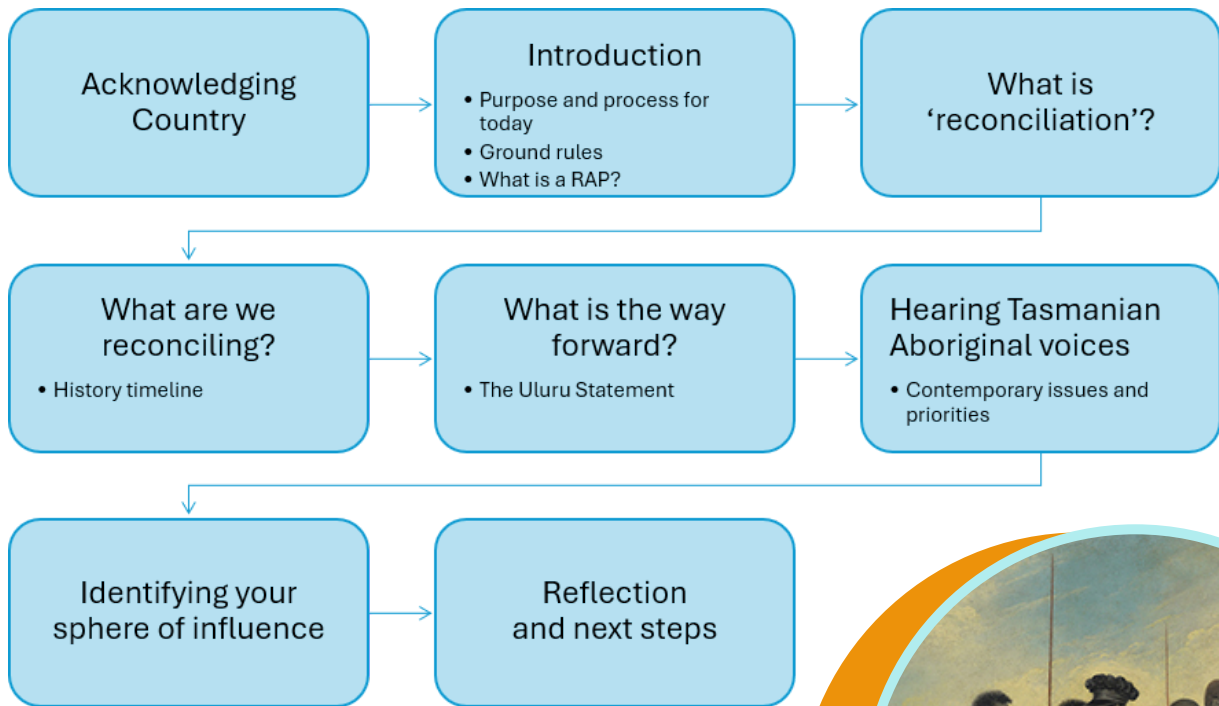


On the Day
